

1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report summarizes the abilities of Albanian municipalities to benefit from and implement projects funded by donors during the period 2021-2023. Prepared under the leadership of the Local Self-Government Support Agency, and with the help of the "Municipalities for Europe" EU project, this report contains summarized data on all the projects in progress, providing the public with important information about the externally funded projects.

The report serves as an important resource for:

- Improving coordination between the central and local governments regarding financial support;
- Harmonization of donor support with local, regional and national development plans;
- The promotion of local government reforms, including the improvement of public services, administrative efficiency and the progress of the decentralization process;
- Increasing communication and transparency on EU integration processes;
- Assessing the capacity of the local government to manage donors' funds;
- Improving public transparency regarding the donors' funds management by the local administration.

This report includes the projects that are being implemented by the municipalities in the 2021-2023 time-frame, a three-year period that coincides with the deadlines for the implementation of projects mostly financed by foreign fundings. In addition, the following reports will take into account the three-year period of the normal average cycle for the implementation of a project.

The 2022 and 2023 reports provide a clear overview of the municipalities' progress in absorbing donor-funded projects and the progress made in the 2020-2022 and 2021-2023 timeframes. The comparison between these two periods shows a growth in some essential aspects, such as the number of projects, the amount of funds secured and the diversification of donors:

Increase of the number of the projects

In the period 2020-2022, 51 municipalities reported a total of 223 projects, while by 2023, the number of projects increased to 263 of them, reported by 53 municipalities. A number of 40 projects were benefited in 2023 alone. This represents an increase of about 17.9% in the total number of projects compared to 2022. Also, the percentage of municipalities that have reported data on such projects has increased from 84% to 87%, showing an increase in the number of municipalities that have obtained foreign funding projects.

Increase of the projects fundings

In the **2021-2022** timeframe, the total amount of funds for the reported projects was **40.8 million** euros, while for the **2021-2023** period this amount increased to **47.9 million euros**. This represents

a 17.4% increase of the total funding. **Donors' fundings have also increased from €34.6 million to €40.92 million**, representing an **increase of 18.27%**.

In terms of percentage, the contribution of donors has remained relatively constant (84.7% in 2021-2022 and 85.41% in 2021-2023), while the Albanian co-financing has undergone a small change, dropping from 15.3% to 14.59%.

Donor diversification

The number of donors, from which the projects implemented by the municipalities are financed, has increased from 12 in the report of 2021-2022 to 14 donors for the period 2021-2023. The share of the European Union in total funding has remained relatively stable with a change from 52.5% to 52.43%. Meanwhile, several other donors such as Italy and the Japanese Government have increased their contributions, with Italy marking an increase from 17.3% to 19.2%, and Japan from 2.9% to 3.4%.

Implementation of projects in specific areas

The focus of the funding is similar in both periods. However, some changes have been observed in the magnitude of the projects carried out in specific areas. Economic development and tourism has remained one of the main areas of the investment, accounting for about 25.4% of them in 2021-2022 and 27.3% in 2021-2023. Another important area, the environmental protection, has maintained almost the same magnitude in both reports, with 24.5% in 2021-2022 and 25.7% in 2021-2023. Meanwhile, social services have suffered a decrease, from 15.6% to 12%.

In general, the report for the years 2021-2023 shows a steady increase in the number of projects and the secured funds, as well as a greater involvement of the municipalities in the implementation of projects. Meanwhile, donor diversification and progress in areas such as economic development and environmental protection remain key factors in meeting local government priorities.

The projects implemented by the municipalities are funded by 14 donors. Projects financed by the EU constitute the largest share, with 52.4% of the total funding. Other donors are the government of Italy (19.22%), Japanese Government (3.43%), Swiss Cooperation (13.25%), Germany (3.19%), the Council of Europe (2.40%), UNDP (2.14%), Austria (2.21%), Sweden (1.08%), Bulgaria (0.28%), British Government (0.14%), Slovenia (0.1%), Multi Donors (0.22%). Projects implemented by municipalities are mainly financed through grant schemes, implemented at the national, regional and inter-regional level.

The Albanian co-financing part for the reported projects is at the level of 14.59%, of which 10.75% is financed from the budget of the municipalities themselves and 3.84% is the contribution of the Central Government.

Out of 263 projects, 144 projects are funded by the European Union. The projects were awarded through the participation of municipalities in grant schemes. The projects are implemented in

partnership with other partners from the countries of the Western Balkans, or from EU member states, or from municipalities on their own.

There are three main EU financial instruments from which municipalities have benefited:

- (i) **National grant schemes:** 28% of the total EU funds, or 7.1 million euros.
- (ii) Cross-border Cooperation Programs and Territorial Cooperation Programs: 68% of funds, or 17.12 million euros.
- (iii) **Union Programs:** 3.5% of the total assets or 0.87 million euros.

All 272 projects were implemented by 53 municipalities, or 87% of the municipalities. 26 municipalities have reported 1 to 3 projects completed during the years 2021-2023, 10 municipalities 4-6 projects, 9 municipalities 7-10 projects and 8 municipalities over 10 projects. The largest number of projects is reported by the municipality of Berat, 20 projects, followed by the municipality of Shkoder with 15 projects, Përmet with 13 projects, Gjirokastër with 12 projects, Elbasan with 12 projects, followed by Tirana and Lezha with 11 projects. 8 municipalities that have not reported any project are: *Poliçan, Dimal, Peqin, Këlcyrë, Bulqizë, Libohovë, Vorë, dhe Konispol.*

Local government priorities have been translated into concrete projects, that directly contribute to their completion. Support from donors is essential not only to address the financial needs of municipalities, but also to diversify their portfolio. This helps attract attention and effort to the new ideas, innovative initiatives and new investments. Moreover, through these projects, the municipalities have the opportunity to learn from the experiences of other countries in the region, by bringing closer to each other the local institutions, communities and individuals, and thus creating a stronger connection with the EU and its integration processes.

Classified according to the areas of local government functions, according to Law 139/2015 "On Local Self-Government", the share of donor-financed projects implemented by municipalities is as follows:

- Economic development and tourism: The grants help stimulating economic growth within
 municipalities by providing support for facility development and providing sub-grants to
 assist small businesses and job training programs. A significant part of these funds is
 dedicated to the financing of activities aimed at the development of tourism, a key sector
 that can play an important role in economic growth and improving the lives of local
 communities. Investments in this field of functions are at the level of 27.3% of all completed
 projects.
- **Environmental protection:** Donor grants are used to support initiatives such as waste management, renewable energy projects or green infrastructure development, helping the municipality achieve its environmental goals. Investments in this field are at the level of 25.7% of all implemented projects.
- Social services: Municipalities often seek to increase the well-being of their communities.
 Grants are focused on activities related to community development programs, or

initiatives aimed at reducing poverty and improving social services. Investments in this field are at the rate of 12% of all realized projects.

- Infrastructure Development and Public Services: Municipalities are using donor grants to finance infrastructure projects such as building or repairing urban and rural roads, schools and health care facilities, and improving public services. Investments in this field are at the level of 11.1% of all implemented projects.
- Culture, cultural heritage and sport: Projects in this are of functions play a decisive role in
 preserving and promoting the identity of the community, encouraging creativity, promoting
 cultural tourism. Project financing in this field is at the level of 13.4% of all completed
 projects.
- Public safety: Projects in this area are mainly contributing to the improvement of fire
 protection services. Funding in this area of functions is at the level of 2.3% of all
 implemented projects.
- Agriculture, forest management: Projects in this area include investments to improve forest management, protect biodiversity, promote the sustainable use of medicinal and aromatic plants. Funding in this area of functions is at the level of 2.5% of all implemented projects.

Two other horizontal areas are "democratization and civil society" (3.2%) and "digitalization of the services", with a corresponding magnitude of 2.4% of the total fundings of the projects.

To maximize the impact of donor-funded investments, it is essential that municipalities have a clear approach and a well-defined strategy for an effective use of the grants. Strong administrative capacities are a key factor in ensuring that donor aid is effective and has a visible impact on the local governance. Investing in improving the governance and building capacities for funds management, especially those of the European Union, is vital for municipal administrations. Furthermore, strong monitoring and accountability mechanisms are needed, in order to ensure that grants are used transparently and in accordance with the intended objectives.

2. METHODOLOGY

This is the second report on the donors' funded projects and implemented by Local Government Units (Municipalities) in Albania. This report contains data based on the information reported by municipalities for the projects implemented during the period 2021-2023, which were funded by donors through calls for applications or directly through funding agencies.

The projects are categorized according to the seven main functional areas of local government, as defined by Law No. 139/2015 "On Local Self-Government", as well as in two additional areas: democratization and civil society, and digitization of services. This categorization is a way to show the efforts of municipalities in allocating resources towards their functional priorities. Currently, the online system presents a limitation, as it allows the categorization of the projects in a single field, even when a project includes several functional fields. Upgrading the system to allow more granular breakdown of interventions is planned, in order to address this limitation in the future.

The data entry process started in May 2024, at the online platform: https://mapping-bpe.al/goDataAnalyze/customize.aspx?lang=al and it was completed in July 2024. All data were checked accordingly for quality and accuracy.


The information uploaded in the database and the accuracy of the project data are the sole responsibility of each municipality.

3. SUMMARY OF DONOR FUNDING

During the reporting period, 2021-2023, Albanian municipalities have benefited from the EU funds, as well as from other donors. These funds were made available through a series of programs and calls for applications announced at the national, regional and transnational level. **The total amount of donor funds** accessed and disbursed directly by local government units during the period 2021-2023 is **47.91 million euros**, of which the donors' contribution is **40.92 million euros** and the **Albanian contribution** is **6.99 million euros**.

<u>Albanian contribution</u> for the projects implemented at the local level during the three-year period was equal to 14.59% of the overall funds, of which 10.75% was financed by the budget of the local units and 3.84% is the contribution of the central government.

Chart 1: Percentage of financing and co-financing of projects implemented during the years 2021-2023 (in %)




The projects implemented by the municipalities are financed by 14 donors. Projects financed by the EU constitute the largest share, with 52.4% of the total funding. Other donors are Italy (19.22%), Japanese Government (3.43%), Swiss Cooperation (13.25%), Germany (3.19%), Council of Europe (2.40%), UNDP (2.14%), Austria (2.21%), Sweden (1.08%), Bulgaria (0.28%), British Government (0.14%), Slovenia (0.1%), multi-Donors (0.22%). Projects implemented by municipalities are mainly financed through grant schemes implemented at the national, regional and inter-regional level.

Projects are focused on the needs and priorities of local governments units, based on their strategic and local plans. Donor-funded projects are helping municipalities improve their services in relation to various statutory functions, as well as strengthen local democratic processes. The European Union funds the largest number of projects, with a total of 149 projects, followed by other donors starting with 26 projects.

The function areas where more investments have been made through projects are: Environmental Protection (25.7%), Economic Development and Tourism (27.3%), Social Services (12%), Infrastructure and Public Services (11.1%) and Culture, Sports, Cultural Heritage (13.4%). The Chart 4 below represents the number of projects by functional areas.




Chart 4: Number of projects implemented by LGUs according as per the main functional areas - 2021-2023

Meanwhile, the Social Services sector has the highest number of implemented projects (61 projects), followed by the Economic Development and Tourism sector, with 54 projects, Environmental protection with 42 projects, and Culture, Sports, Cultural Heritage with 38 projects.

Table 1 below represents the information on the amount for each donor, the projects that are implemented by the municipalities, based on the areas of local government functions.

4. STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECTS

Out of 263 projects implemented by the 53 municipalities in Albania during the years 2021-2023, more than half of them, 146, have been finalized by 2023, while 116 are still being implemented or pending, only 1 project has been suspended

The overall level of disbursement of funds for completed and ongoing projects at the end of 2023 is 61.22%, while the level of disbursement for completed projects in total is 43%.

5. GEOGRAPHICAL SPREAD OF PROJECTS

In total, there are 53 municipalities that have reported in the online database the information related to the projects in implementation during the years 2021 - 2023. As for the number of projects per municipality, according to the data, 26 out of 53 municipalities that are implementing at least one project, or 49% of them, have implemented 1 to 3 projects during this period, while 8 municipalities, or 15% of them, had over 10 projects in process of implementation.




Chart 6: Percentage of municipalities as per the number of completed projects (in%)

The largest number of projects is reported by the municipality of Berat, 20 projects, followed by the municipality of Shkodra with 15 projects, Përmet with 13 projects, Gjirokastër with 12 projects, Elbasan with 12 projects, followed by Tirana and Lezha with 11 projects. 8 municipalities that have not reported any project are: *Poliçan, Dimal, Peqin, Këlcyrë, Bulqizë, Libohovë, Vorë, dhe Konispol.*





Chart 7: Number of projects by Municipality

In terms of general funding, namely for projects managed by municipalities, the municipalities of Berat, Tirana, Gjirokastër, Përmet and Roskovec have reported the largest amount of project funds received during the years 2021-2023. 6. FUNDINGS AS PER THE DONORS

6.1. Financial contribution of the EU


The European Union is the largest donor in Albania, as well as the largest donor that finances a large number of projects at the local level through a variety of foreign aid delivery mechanisms, such as technical assistance, infrastructure development projects, as well as through various cross-border cooperation programs, transnational and Union Programs.


Among the 263 projects managed by the municipalities, 144 projects are financed by the EU. One of these programs, ROMACTED, is jointly financed with the Council of Europe. The total amount of EU-funded projects is 25.1 million Euros, representing 52.4% of the total funding received from donors through calls for applications.

Most projects implemented by the municipalities through EU grants are function of economic development and tourism (27.3% of EU grants), addressing environmental issues (25.7% of EU grants), improving cultural services, Sports and Cultural heritage (13.4%), improving infrastructure and public services (11.1%), and other areas such as digitization of services, public safety, etc.

The EU contribution through grants varies from 100% to 85%, depending on the grant scheme. The average percentage of EU contribution for all grants managed by municipalities is 85.55%. Regarding EU programs, the local contribution, as a necessary co-financing, ranges from 5% to 15%. The average magnitude of co-financing for Albanian municipalities is 14.45%, or 3.63 million euros. Co-financing is provided directly from the municipal budget, at the level of 8.25%, while 6.20% of the co-financing is supported by central government funds.



Projects that the Albanian municipalities obtained are financed by the Pre-Accession Instrument. Municipalities have benefited from the following financial programs of the European Union:

- (i) National grant schemes;
- (ii) International and Territorial Cooperation Programs;
- (iii) Union programs.

The chart below shows the support of the EU for the funding of the programs, as well as the number of the projects implemented by the Albanian municipalities in each of such during the years 2021-2023.




Chart 13: Number of the completed projects and the share of the fundings by EU (mln EUR)

6.1.1. National grant schemes

The financing in the national programs framework financed by the IPA instrument has secured 26.5% of the total EU funds dedicated to projects implemented by the local government during the years 2021-2023. 40 projects have been supported through IPA funding, and the contracted amount coming from the EU, as reported by the municipalities, is 5.57 million euros.

The main grant schemes launched starting from August 2020 are as follows:

- ➤ EU for socio-economic development (as an alternative to cultivation and trafficking of narcotic plants), with the global objective of improving access to socio-economic development and employment opportunities, services and facilities in communities vulnerable to cannabis cultivation and trafficking". During the years 2021-2023, there have been 10 projects reported by the municipalities that were financed by this grant scheme, with a total amount of 2.97 million euros.
- ➤ **EU for municipalities** is aiming to support the potential for the development of municipalities and improve the socio-economic and environmental conditions of local communities in Albania. During the years 2021-2023, 17 municipalities have reported projects supported by this grant scheme, with a total amount of 1.61 million Euros

- ➤ **Local Social Inclusion:** the program aims to contribute to strengthening the capacities at a municipality level for the creation and provision of social care services, inclusive employment and vocational education. For the year 2021-2023, there have been reports regarding 7 of such projects, with a total amount of 1.13 million euros.
- ➤ **ROMACTED II** is a Joint Regional Program between European Union and Council of Europe, which aims to promote good governance and empower the Roma through increased participation in local policy-making and the implementation of local actions. During the years 2021-2023, municipalities have reported 2 projects financed by this grant scheme, with a total amount of 0.21 million euros.
- ➤ Regional Program of Local Democracy (ReLOaD 2) is a regional initiative with a special focus on youth, CSOs and communities at the local level. The total amount of 8 projects carried out by Albanian municipalities with the support of the program is reported to be around 1.14 million euros.

6.1.2. EU multi-benefits programs

Local government can also access funds under EU multi-beneficiary programs. The total amount of projects funding, in which the municipalities of Albania have participated, in partnership with the municipalities or partner organizations of the Western Balkans and EU member states, is 72.33 million euros. Of this amount, 25% or 18 million euros is the amount of funds managed only by Albanian municipalities.

The IPA II CBC Greece - Albania program is the program with 39% of the total amount of funds that supports the local projects implemented by the municipalities of Albania (in cooperation with Greek partners). Erasmus Plus and URBACT 4 are the two programs where the level of access by municipalities is the lowest, respectively 0.4% and 1.2%.

6.1.3 Cross-border Cooperation and Territorial Cooperation Programs

The CBC and Territorial Cooperation programs turn out to be the ones that contribute the highest financial support at the local level covering 68.27% of European Union funds, or 17.12 million euros, dedicated to projects implemented by local government units during the years 2021-2023.

As presented in the table, the total amount of the financing of the projects implemented by Albanian municipalities in partnership with other partners from the participating countries is 50.43 million euros, of which 17.29 million euros, or 34%, is the total amount of funds managed directly from Albanian municipalities.

The municipalities are implementing 95 projects through these programs, covering a wide range of their field of functions and competences, such as education, digitalization of services, infrastructure, art, cultural and historical heritage, economic development, tourism, forest management, environment, etc.

6.1.4 Union programs

Union Programs are another financial instrument of the EU where the municipalities may apply for funds. Starting from 2018, municipalities have added their information to Union Programs, as well as added applications for seeking grants from these programs. This explains the limited number, only 18 projects, and the low rate of benefit from Union Programs.

The main programs for which municipalities have received grants, in partnership with other partners are:

- **Europe for Citizens** aims to support initiatives to strengthen the memory of the European history and to increase citizen participation at the level of EU policies. 11 municipalities are implementing projects with other partners from EU member states and Western Balkan countries.
- **Horizon 2020** is a research and innovation funding program. Only 3 municipalities are implementing 4 projects financed by this program.
- *Erasmus Plus* is the EU's program for education, training, youth and sport. 3 projects were implemented through grants given by this program.

The 18 projects financed by the Union Programs share % of the total projects of the Union Programs and 3% of the total projects financed by the EU managed by the municipalities.

Italian government

The Italian-Albanian Development Cooperation Program includes an innovative financing mechanism for Albania: The Development Debt Swap Agreement (IADSA). This instrument aims to support the implementation of projects in the social sector, proposed by Albanian public institutions and agreed upon within the framework of bilateral cooperation. Projects are selected through calls for proposals, which are announced periodically and are open for application from Albanian public institutions, including local government units. Municipalities have actively participated in the applications for the projects proposed in the first two grant schemes announced by the program.





Chart 15: Share of funded projects by functional areas





In total, the municipalities have reported upon 22 projects awarded by the IADSA program. The total amount of the funded projects is 9.21 million euros, which represents 19.2% of the total donor funding managed by the municipalities. Most of the projects are focused on interventions that support economic development (26%), improving of the services in culture and Sports areas (25%), followed by projects aimed at improving social services (25%) and infrastructure of public services (19%).

6.2 Swiss Government

Switzerland is among Albania's main partners in bilateral cooperation. The main objective of this cooperation is to support the development of a functional democracy, strong and effective institutions, as well as the improvement of public services. It is also aimed to contribute to the creation of a stable, inclusive and competitive market economy, to help mitigate the impacts of climate change and to achieve compliance with European standards and values. The municipalities have reported upon 26 projects implemented with the support of the Swiss Cooperation program, with a total fund of 6.35 million euros, which constitute 13.3% of the total projects financed by donors managed by the municipalities. Most of the projects are focused on environmental protection (56%), followed by projects to improve infrastructure and public services (23%) and economic protection and development (17%).

Regional Development Program (RDPA) was a joint program of the Swiss Development Cooperation (SDC) and the Austrian Development Agency (ADA).

6.3 Government of Japan

The Japanese government is giving its support to Albania through JICA/Japan International Cooperation Agency. Municipalities have benefited from JICA's support mainly for the improvement of infrastructure and public services (51%), followed by environmental protection (27%). The total amount of projects for which the municipalities have applied for support from JICA is 1.6 million euros (equivalent), or 3.4% of the total projects financed by donors. 17 municipalities have reported that they have received equipment and support from JICA for a total of 17 projects.




Chart 18: Share of projects financed, divided by functional areas

6.4 German government

Albanian municipalities are benefiting from the support of the German government provided through the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ). There have been 11 projects that several municipalities have reported to have implemented and managed, in the 2021-2023 timeframe, with a total amount of 1.53 million euros or 3.5% of all projects financed by donors. 7 municipalities are implementing 11 projects aimed at improving municipal social services, with a special focus on people with disabilities and vulnerable groups, as well as socio-economic rehabilitation of the returned immigrants. In addition, GIZ is supporting municipalities to increase employment opportunities for the citizens through their engagement in community work.




Chart 19: Share of projects financed as per the functional areas

Other donors, such as UNDP and bilateral donors, such as the Austrian Development Agency, the Swedish government, the Bulgarian government, the Slovenian government are providing support to municipalities through grants, supporting them to improve the municipal services and the living conditions of the communities.

7 THE ROLE OF FUNDING IN SUPPORTING THE FUNCTIONS AND PRIORITIES OF LGUS

Local government priorities have been translated into donor-funded projects in a variety of programs at national and regional levels. The local government has been given essential support not only through financing their needs and priorities in various functional areas and services of the local government, but also towards diversifying their portfolio by drawing their attention and efforts towards new ideas, innovative initiatives, investments, as well as learning from the experience of other countries in the region, bringing institutions, communities and individuals closer to each other and closer to the EU.

The law "On Local Self-Government" no. 139/2015 defines seven areas of local government competences as shown in the chart below.



Local government priorities have turned into concrete projects financed by donors through a series of national and regional programs. The support provided to the local government stretches not only on financing of priorities and needs in key areas of local government, but also over the diversification of their portfolio. This assistance has focused the efforts of municipalities towards new initiatives, innovative ideas and investments, benefiting from the experience of other countries in the region and bringing institutions, communities and citizens closer to each other, as well as to the EU.

For analytical purposes, in addition to the seven areas defined by the law, two cross-sectoral areas have been assessed: digitalization of services and democratization and cooperation with civil society. These areas are playing an important role in improving the quality of services provided by local government, increasing the use of information technology and strengthening the participation of civil society organizations in service delivery and decision-making processes.

In applying for funding from donors, municipalities aim to increase their financial resources to improve the local services they provide to their citizens. In addition to improving these services, the projects have a significant impact on strengthening local governance and democracy, raising the capacities of the municipalities in the efficient and transparent management of foreign aid.

The experience gained from managing donor-funded projects helps municipalities improve their skills in financial management and increase transparency in the use of funds. Also, these projects often contribute to strengthening local democracy, supporting cooperation between local authorities and civil society organizations or community groups, to strengthen dialogue and citizen participation in decision-making processes.




Chart 20: Share of donor-funded projects by functional areas (%)


7.1 Economic development and Tourism

Municipalities have reported 54 projects on the financing of interventions in the field of functional development. The total financing amounts to 12.05 million euros, of which 10.37 million euros from donors and 1.68 million euros co-financing. 57% of the projects are financed by the projects funded by the EU, with a total amount of 6.8 million euros, followed by the Italian government through the IADSA program at the level of 2.4 million euros or 20.18% of the total projects implemented.

The development of tourism is the main focus of implemented municipal projects. The development of tourism, the relevant infrastructure, the promotion of tourism, aiming to encourage potential tourists to travel to local destinations through the dissemination of information, better marketing of the local products, is one of the objectives of several projects implemented by municipalities, together with other projects on local support, market development and small business development.

Improvement of local infrastructure in function of tourism development

The improvement of local infrastructure has been an essential step in the development of tourism in some municipalities of Albania. In Dropull, a project has been undertaken for the restoration of municipal roads in order to eliminate the isolation of mountainous and disadvantaged areas. This project, known as EXTROVERT ROAD, funded by the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania-Greece program, aims to improve access and mobility in the region. Also, the municipality of Lezhë has invested in improving the road infrastructure for pedestrians and cyclists in the village of Ishull Lezhë. This project, financed by Swiss cooperation through the Regional Development Program (RDPA), aims to increase access and safety for all groups of society, while also supporting the development of tourism. In Kavaje, with the support of Italy and the IADSA program, the reconstruction of the "Figiri Kurti" kindergarten has been carried out, which significantly improves the quality of the infrastructure for early education, having a direct impact on the local community and increasing the attractiveness of the area. Meanwhile, in the municipality of Përmet, with funding from JICA - the Japanese Government, a waste collection truck and several containers have been provided to support efficient waste management, thus improving cleanliness and public services in the area. A similar project by JICA has been implemented in the municipality of Tropoja, where the cleaning service has been improved, contributing to a cleaner and safer environment for residents and visitors. In Gjirokastër, a project has been developed for the construction of a local market for the Roma community, which is financed by the European Union through the ROMACTED

program. This project aims to increase the economic and social integration of the Roma community, improving the local infrastructure and providing a suitable location for the development of their commercial activities. All these projects aim to create the best infrastructural conditions that promote the development of tourism, promote the community and support the economic development of the respective areas.

Promotion of tourist resources and alternatives:

The promotion of tourism resources and alternatives in Albania is a key element for the economic development and the promotion of sustainable tourism in different regions of the country. In this context, a number of projects have been implemented to promote the potential of local tourism and to increase awareness on the cultural and natural heritage and new activities of alternative tourism. In Diber, the "Discover Dibra and Debar" project, funded by a group of donors through USAID, aims to discover and promote the region's attractions, connecting the two cities and helping to build a common tourist identity. This project helps increase local capacities for tourism development, bringing more visitors and economic development to the area. In Durrës, the project "APPRODI PLUS: "From Ancient Sea Routes to Ecotourism Destinations PLUS" is supported by the European Union through the Interreg ADRION 2014-2020 program. It aims to use ancient sea routes as a basis for creating eco-destinations tourism, promoting the development of maritime tourism and strengthening cultural ties between the countries of the Adriatic area.

The project in Elbasan, "Krusheva and Elbasan – popular tourist destinations", funded by the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania-Macedonia program, aims to promote Elbasan as an attractive destination for tourists, combining the culture and history of the area with the potential for sustainable and diverse tourism. In Kukes, the Shishtavec Adventure Park is a project financed by Swiss Cooperation through the Regional Development Program (RDPA). This park offers opportunities for recreational and Sports activities related to nature and adventure, positioning Shishtavec as an attractive destination for tourists looking for new experiences and extraordinary natural attractions. The "Development and Promotion of Extreme Tourism in the Greece-Albania Cross-Border Area (EX.TOUR)" project in Përmet is an initiative that aims to develop extreme tourism in the Albania-Greece cross-border area. With funding from the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania-Greece program, this project helps create conditions for the development of extreme Sports and recreational activities, strengthening cross-border cooperation and promoting the area's tourism offers.

In Tepelena, the project "Development of Cultural Tourism through the Discovery of Cultural Paths and Routes in the Cross-Border Area", also financed by the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania-Greece program, aims to promote the cultural tourism through the development of walking paths and cultural routes. This initiative aims to raise awareness on the cultural heritage and create new opportunities for the development of sustainable tourism in the region.

In Pogradec, the project "Promotion of Extroversion in Cultural, Folkloric and Gastronomic Tourism", financed by the European Union within the IPA CBC Albania-Greece program, focuses on promoting the cultural and culinary heritage of the area. This project aims to strengthen cross-

border ties through the promotion of folklore and gastronomic traditions, turning Pogradec into an attractive destination for tourists in search of authentic experiences.

• Increasing capacities in the local market:

Increasing capacities in the local market is an important objective for many regions of Albania, aiming at local economic development and increasing opportunities for entrepreneurs and local communities. In Berat, the project "For Economic Recovery and Sustainability", funded by the United Nations Development Program (UNDP), aims to promote sustainable economic development and improve living conditions for the community, providing support for various economic and social activities that promote the long-term development of the area. In Dropull, the Council of Europe has funded the project "Accelerator and Incubator of Social Enterprises for Women and Youth of the Greek Minority SOCIAL", which is focused on promoting social entrepreneurship for women and youth of the Greek minority. This project aims to create opportunities to develop new skills and increase the participation of these groups of population in the labor market, supporting local initiatives and the creation of new businesses. In Fier, the European Union has financed the project "Cross-Border Cooperation and Competitiveness for SMEs (3C4SME)" within the IPA CBC Italy-Albania-Montenegro program. The main objective of this project is to support cross-border cooperation and increase the competitiveness of small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) in the region, promoting innovation and sustainable economic development.

In Gjirokastër, the project "RDPA LAZARAT BIME MEDICINALE", financed by Austria/ADA, is focused on the development of capacities for the cultivation of medicinal plants. This initiative aims to diversify the local economy, promote sustainable agricultural practices and create new opportunities for employment and income growth in the local community of Lazarati. The project "MAT YESi – More Alternatives Toward Youths Education and Socio-economic Integration" in Mat, financed by the European Union through the EU socio-economic development program, aims to offer different alternatives for the education and socio-economic integration of the young people. The project supports vocational training, employment promotion and increased opportunities for the young people in the region, contributing to the long-term economic development of the area. In Përmet, the European Union has funded within the IPA program the project "Establishment of Business Clubs for Encouraging Entrepreneurship in the Cross-Border Zone". This project aims to create business clubs to promote entrepreneurship and innovation in the Albania-Greece crossborder area, supporting networking, training and the development of new skills for small and medium-sized businesses. These projects have a significant impact on increasing local capacities, promoting entrepreneurship, developing social enterprises and supporting young people, creating new opportunities for sustainable economic development throughout Albania.

• Development of local economic infrastructure:

In Gjirokastër, within the ROMACTED Program of the European Union, a project has been developed for the construction of a local market dedicated to the Roma community. This project aims to strengthen the social and economic integration of this community, creating new spaces for the development of trade and the support of local businesses. Italy, through the IADSA program, has

supported a number of economic development projects in rural areas. In Korça, a market network has been set up for local farmers, promoting local products as key elements for the rural development of the region. Also, in Lushnja, a livestock market has been built in the Bubullimë Administrative Unit, improving the infrastructure for trading agricultural and livestock products. In Përmet, a project has been developed to promote sustainable entrepreneurship through the development of rural businesses for women, young people and farmers. This project aims to create a sustainable way of doing business through the reconstruction of the city's cultural center and the establishment of an info point for information and tourism promotion, as part of the "Art Market" project. Furthermore, with the support of the IADSA program of Italy a project has been developed in Pogradec, aiming at creating a sustainable way to develop business and promote cultural activities, helping women and the young generation to develop their entrepreneurial skills and empower the local economy.


7.2 Environment protection

Municipalities are implementing 42 projects that contribute to addressing environmental issues and implementing services in the functional area of environmental protection. All 42 projects are implemented by 28 local government units. The total amount of projects implemented in this functional area is up to 11.99 million euros, of which 10.18 million euros are donors' contributions and 1.8 million euros are co-financing funds. 21 projects have been finalized in 2023. As noted in the table below, the EU has provided 6.45 million euros or 53.8% of donor funds followed by the Swiss government with 3.6 million euros or 30% of the total. The amount of the donor's contribution.

Below are some funded interventions to improve services related to environmental protection:

• In the field of water and waste management infrastructure.

In the field of water and waste management infrastructure, a number of projects have been implemented to improve these services in different areas of Albania. In Dibër, with the support of JICA - the Japanese Government, a truck was provided for the collection of waste and containers

for their disposal. This project aims to improve waste management in the area and create a cleaner environment for residents. Meanwhile, in Kukës, the European Union, through the IPA CBC Albania-Kosovo program, has financed the "Clean Water in Gjakovë and Kukës" project, which aims to improve the supply of clean water. This initiative positively affects the quality of life of the residents of Kukes and Gjakova, ensuring sustainable and safe access to water resources. In Roskovec, two important projects were undertaken, that focused on waste management. The first project, supported by GIZ, involves the construction of a composting field for the processing and recycling of organic waste. This initiative aims to reduce solid waste and improve its management in a more sustainable manner. The second project, funded by JICA - Japanese Government, provides a truck and containers for waste collection and transportation. This improves the capacities of Roskovec municipality in waste treatment and reduces environmental pollution.

Likewise, in Prrenjas, a similar project financed by JICA was implemented, to supply the municipality with a garbage collection truck. This project aims to improve waste management services and strengthen the infrastructure for their treatment and collection, contributing to the protection of the environment and the well-being of the local community.

• In the field of the energy efficiency:

In the field of energy efficiency, several projects have played an important role in increasing the use of more sustainable energy resources and energy efficiency in Albania. In the city of Berat, a project supported by Swiss Cooperation through the SECO program aims to increase energy efficiency through the installation of an efficient public lighting system.

In Korça, another Swiss Cooperation project through the SECO program is "The Municipality's Smart Energy Project", which focuses on promoting the use of smart energy. The project "SOLIS - Cross-Border Cooperation for Energy Efficiency Using Solar Energy " in Finiq, funded by the European Union within the IPA CBC Albania-Greece program, is a cross-border initiative that promotes the use of solar energy. In Përmet, the project "Municipality with intelligent use of Energy (SEMP)", also financed by Swiss Cooperation within the SECO program, aims to promote the efficient and sustainable use of energy. The project includes increasing awareness and the implementation of sustainable practices to ensure a reduced consumption of energy and its environmental impact.

In Kavaja, the European Union-funded project "Promotion of Innovative Practices and Tools for Reducing Carbon Emissions and Improving Energy Efficiency in the Municipality of Kavaja", within the EU for Municipalities program, aims to reduce carbon emissions and improve energy efficiency in the area. These energy efficiency projects contribute to the sustainable development of the regions where they are implemented, by reducing energy consumption.

• In the field of climate change:

In the field of climate change, a number of projects have been implemented in Albania to protect the environment, reduce the impact of climate change and promote sustainable practices. In Berat, the project funded by Sweden/SIDA includes the planting of trees on Mount Partizan, aiming to improve the local climate and protect biodiversity. In Maliq, the "Flood Prevention for Environmental Protection" project, funded by the European Union within the IPA CBC Albania-Macedonia program, aims to prevent floods and protect the environment. The project "Green

Leap - Towards the local green economy through smart investments" in Has, financed by the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania-Kosovo program, aims to develop a green economy in the area. In Shkodër, the project "Municipality with Intelligent Energy Use (SEMP)", financed by Swiss Cooperation through the SECO program, focuses on promoting the use of energy in an efficient and sustainable manner.


7.3 Social services

Supporting municipalities to improve their services is essential for promoting well-being and quality of life for residents. Municipalities play a critical role in providing social services. The projects carried out by municipalities aimed at improving social services amount to 7.45 million euros, of which 6.55 million from donor funds, and 0.9 million from co-financing. During the years 2021 - 2023, 61 projects were implemented by the municipalities. By the end of 2023, 31 out of 61 projects have been completed. Projects funded by EU grants totaled 3 million euros, or 40%, followed by Italy, 2.3 million euros or 31%, as the second largest donor for improving service delivery. social from the municipalities.

Below are some interventions in the functional field of social service:

• Installation and operation of multifunctional centers:

In Delvina, with the support of UNDP, a multifunctional center has been created that offers services to groups in need. Another important project is the reconstruction of the Multifunctional Youth Center in Dibër, financed by Italy through IADSA. This center is designed to provide a space for youth, where they can engage in social and educational activities. In Maliq, UNDP has created a multifunctional center that offers various social services to the community, while in Shkodër, a successful model of integrated social services within multifunctional centers has been implemented, financed by Italy through IADSA. This center aims to promote social inclusion and community development, offering a wide range of services to all citizens, with a focus on the most

marginalized. One of these initiatives is the project "4 Wheels in Service – Modeling the Delivery of Mobile Social Services for the Needy" in Devoll, funded by UNDP. Another important project is the creation of the multifunctional center in Maliq, financed by UNDP. This center aims to provide a range of social services that support the community and the inclusion of vulnerable groups. In Prrenjas, the European Union has supported the creation of a community center called "Community Center for Disability Services (C2DS)" that focuses on providing services to people with disabilities. Shkodra has successfully implemented a multifunctional model of integrated social services with the help of IADSA (Italy), where the center aims to improve social inclusion and community development. Also, in Skrapar, a multifunctional creative center has been built in the "5 Shtatori" neighborhood.

• Improvement of infrastructure and services for persons with disabilities:

Several projects implemented in Albania in the field of improving infrastructure and services for persons with disabilities have focused on providing specialized support and creating opportunities for the social inclusion of this category. In Kamez Municipality, the project financed by UNDP aims to establish integrated health and social services for children with disabilities. The aim is to increase the quality of care provided to these children and improve accessibility to health and social services, supporting their development and well-being. In Mat, the UNDP-funded "No One Left Behind" project focuses on improving the quality of services for people with disabilities. This project aims to integrate these individuals into the daily life of the community, ensuring that they receive the necessary support and have opportunities for a more complete social inclusion. In Prrenjas, the European Union has funded the creation of a community center for services dedicated to people with disabilities, within the EU socio-economic development program. DEVOLL: Devoll Skills Recovery (DAR), funded by UNDP, is a project that aims to improve the rehabilitation and social inclusion of people with disabilities in Devoll Municipality, providing support services and equal access for them. Providing services to people with disabilities is a UNDP initiative that aims to create and strengthen various mechanisms that ensure inclusion and appropriate services for the people with disabilities in the Korça area, including social care activities and support services. The improvement of services and personal development of people with disabilities in the territory of Roskovec Municipality, financed by UNDP, aims to improve the quality of social services for the people with disabilities. Integrated Social Services for the inclusion of children and youth with disabilities, funded by the European Union, aims to provide integrated social services for children and youth with disabilities in Shijak Municipality. The Social Center for Persons with Disabilities, funded by Italy within the IADSA program, is a center dedicated to providing integrated services for the people with disabilities in Tirana. Another project is Family Services for Children with Disabilities and Strengthening of Services at the Malik Community Center, funded by Bulgaria.

• Social inclusion and protection for vulnerable groups.

In Albania, social inclusion and protection of vulnerable groups are key goals of several projects funded by international donors. One of these projects is in Elbasan, where UNDP has undertaken

an initiative to improve the access of violence survivor women and girls to specialized support services.

In Fier, the European Union has supported the "New Opportunities for Fier" project, within the framework of the EU socio-economic development program. A similar project has been implemented in Kukës, "New opportunities for Kukës - NOK", also financed by the European Union within the socio-economic development program. Another project aimed at social inclusion is implemented in Kamez, where the European Union has supported a social inclusion program to improve the access of vulnerable groups to social services and support their successful integration into society. In Korça the UNDP has implemented the project "Social Inclusion for Change," which aims to promote the inclusion of vulnerable groups in the social and economic life of the city. In Shijak the project "Integrated Social Services for the Inclusion of Children and Youth with Disabilities", funded by the European Union, aims to ensure the inclusion of children and youth with disabilities in society. In Lushnja the Council of Europe has financed the "ROMACTED II" project, which aims to promote the social inclusion of the Roma and Egyptian communities in the country. Furthermore, in Roskovec, the project "Improving Services and Personal Development of Persons with Disabilities", financed by UNDP, has been developed, which focuses on creating conditions for the inclusion of these individuals in the social life of the community.

Capacity building for social workers.

In the field of raising the capacities of social workers and improving the quality of teaching, a number of projects have been undertaken that aim to strengthen the capacities of social workers and improve educational services in Albania.

In Kamez, the project "Improved and New Inclusive Capacities of Local Units for Successful Social Integration of Vulnerable Subjects", financed by the European Union within the "Local Social Inclusion" program, aims to train and increase the capacities of social workers in this area. In Korça the UNDP has supported the "Social Inclusion for Change" project, which focuses on empowering social workers through training and development activities. In Maliq the UNDP has supported the creation of a "Daycare Center for Children", which aims to create a safe educational environment and improve the quality of teaching through daily educational activities, while in Lushnja, the project "Distance and Remote Education to Achieve More (DREAM) funded by the European Union within the Erasmus Plus program, focuses on improving the quality of teaching through the use of new technologies. In Shkodër the project "Empowering the Community through Providing Alternative Daily Services for Children and Families" supported by the UNDP aims to improve the quality of educational services through daily educational and developmental activities. Another important project for improving the quality of services for children is the one implemented in Kuçove, financed by Swiss Cooperation, in the framework of the program "HAP/Health for Program". In Kukes the project "Integration of Children in the Process of Education and Development in a Pleasant Environment", financed by the government of Bulgaria, focuses on improving of educational conditions and the creation of a pleasant and suitable environment for children's development.

• Improving the quality of teaching:

In Maliq, with the support of the UNDP, a "Daycare Center for Children" has been created, that offers a safe and dedicated environment for the educational development of children. In Lushnja, the project "Distance & Remote Education to Achieve More (DREAM)", financed by the European Union within the Erasmus Plus program, focuses on the use of technology to improve the quality of teaching. In Shkodër the "Community Empowerment through the Provision of Daily Alternative Services for Children and Families" project, funded by the UNDP, aims to improve the educational and support services for children and families. Another project aimed at improving teaching is the one implemented in Kuçova, where Swiss Cooperation has supported the reconstruction of the square and sports corner of the 9-year-old school "Koço Korçari" within the framework of the "HAP/Health for Program". In Kukes the government of Bulgaria has funded the project "Empowering the Community through the Provision of Alternative Day Services for Children and Families", which aims to create better conditions for the education of children and provide a pleasant and suitable environment for their development.

• Increase of the number of health services:

The increase of the number of the health services in Albania has been a priority, in order to improve the life quality of vulnerable groups and local communities. In Kukës, the project "We do not remain behind," financed by Swiss Cooperation within the framework of the HAP/Health for Program, aims to ensure better access to health services for the vulnerable groups and to ensure quality services for the entire community. In Tirana, with the support of the Italian IADSA program, the "Social Center for people with disabilities in Tirana" has been established, that is a multifunctional center that offers integrated health and social services for people with disabilities. In Kamëz the UNDP has launched a project for improving the access to the health and social services for people with disabilities. In Roskovec, the "Romacted II" project has been developed by the Council of Europe, which aims to promote the social and health inclusion of the Roma and Egyptian communities.

7.4 Infrastructure and public services


There are 37 projects implemented during the years 2021-2023, managed by 22 local government units. The national financing amounts to 7.04 million euros, of which 6.12 million are from donor funds and 0.91 million from local co-financing. The chart below shows that projects financed by EU grants cover 39% of the funds managed by municipalities for projects aimed at improving municipal infrastructure.

Below there is brief information on investments made through grants managed by municipalities to improve municipal infrastructure and public services:

• In the area of the urban transport services:

In Durrës, the "Urban Transport" project, financed by the European Union through the Interreg MED 2014-2020 program, aims to develop and improve the city's urban transport system. In Lezha, the project "Smart Land — Sustainable mobility linked to public transportation in rural areas in the Southern Adriatic," funded by the European Union under the EUSAIR/Ionian Adriatic program, aims to improve mobility in rural areas of the region. In Shkodër the "Park4SUMP" project, funded by the European Union within the HORIZON EUROPE program, focuses on smart parking management to promote sustainable urban transportation. Another important project in the field of transportation is Lezhë: RE-GEN — Regeneration of public space through integrated urban sports centers for the participation of young citizens, financed by the European Union within the framework of the URBACT IV program.

• In the field of urban infrastructure:

In Belsh, with the funding from the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania- North Macedonia program, a new bridge is being built within the project "Construction of the pier of the Belsh bridge". This project aims to improve the connection and infrastructural access of the city, creating better conditions for transport and transit in this area. In Gjirokastër, the project "Rehabilitation of public lighting on the street of Zinxhira", financed by the Italian government within the framework of IADSA, aims to improve the public lighting system on one of the main streets of the city. Another project is implemented in Librazhd, where Swiss Cooperation, through the RDPA program, has supported the "Reconstruction of the center of the village of Fushë Stude and the construction of the bicycle path". In Skrapar, the project "Revitalization of the multifunctional cinema of the municipality of Skrapar" is another initiative funded by Italy under the IADSA program.

In Lezha, the project "ProLIGHTMed - Progressive solutions for the optimization of public lighting in the EURO-MED area", financed by the European Union under the program IPA CBC Albania-Montenegro, aims to improve the public lighting system in the Mediterranean area through efficient and sustainable energy. Also, in Lezhë, the project "RE-GEN – Regeneration of public space through integrated urban sports centers for the participation of young citizens" financed by

the European Union within the framework of the URBACT IV program, focuses on the regeneration of public spaces and the creation of urban sports centers. In Kamez the "UR Impact" project, funded by the European Union within the URBACT IV program, aims at sustainable urban development and social inclusion through various infrastructural interventions and the creation of public spaces that support the community and urban development of the city.

• Improvement of educational infrastructure facilities:

In Devoll, the project financed by the Italian Government through IADSA aims to improve the educational infrastructure in the Miras administrative unit. This project focuses on creating an inclusive educational environment for every child, ensuring better conditions for educational development and access to quality education. The project aims to modernize schools and improve the quality of the existing infrastructure.

In Gjirokastër, with the support of the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania-Greece program, the upper secondary school "Se Bashku" is being reconstructed. This project aims to create a safer and more convenient learning environment for students, improving the school's infrastructure and increasing the quality of the educational experience for children in this area. In Kuçova the "Reconstruction of the Koço Korçari School" project is another important initiative financed by the European Union, within the framework of the EU program for Municipalities. This project aims to improve teaching and learning conditions in the local school by renovating the building and creating a more suitable environment for children's education. In the Municipality of Mat, the project "Educational Roads for Children and the Community", funded bythe government of Italy through IADSA, aims to improve the infrastructure that supports the education. In Rrëshen, the "EU4Kids" project financed by the European Union through the EU program for Municipalities aims to create better conditions for children's education. Another project that contributes to the improvement of the educational infrastructure is Elbasan: Reconstruction of the playground at the 9-year-old Qamil Guranjaku school, financed by Swiss Cooperation through the HAP/Health for Program.

In Tepelena, the project for the reconstruction of ambulatory primary care centers in rural areas, financed by Italy through IADSA, also includes improving the conditions of some facilities that serve to educate the community on health and well-being, creating a link between education and services health in rural areas.

7.5 Culture, sport, cultural heritage


The local government units play a crucial role in protecting cultural heritage within their jurisdictions. Cultural protection and promotion of heritage, such as historic sites, monuments, traditions, artefacts and intangible cultural elements that are central to a community's identity and history. They play a vital role in promoting and supporting sporting and recreational activities within their communities. Their involvement in sport can have multiple benefits, including promoting physical health, fostering community cohesion and boosting the local economy. By investing in sports infrastructure and programs, the municipalities contribute to the well-being and vitality of their local areas.

There are 38 projects implemented during the years 2021-2023, managed by local government units with a total funding of 5.98 million euros, of which 4.84 million euros are donor funds and 1.14 million euros of the Albanian government contribution.

Reconstruction and revitalization of the cultural and art facilities:

The reconstruction and revitalization of the cultural and art facilities in Albania is a priority for many municipalities, aiming to improve the cultural infrastructure and revive artistic and social activities. These projects are focused on the reconstruction of theaters, cinemas and cultural centers, creating new spaces for the development of communities. In Gjirokastër, the project for the reconstruction of the Zihni Sako Theater, in Memaliaj, the reconstruction of the former City Cinema, in Përmet, the project "Revitalization of the multifunctional cinema" in the municipality of Përmet, in Mirdita, the project "Revitalization of cultural activities" in Mirdita are important initiatives financed by the government Italy through IADSA. In Përmet, another project is AR.C.H.ETHICS - Architecture, Citizenship, History and Ethics to Shape Dissonant Heritage in European Cities, funded by the European Union within the URBACT IV program.

Within the European Union's efforts to promote economic development and social inclusion, a number of projects have been implemented to create local clusters and incubators of social enterprises. These projects aim to support the development of the culture, tourism and innovation sectors, encouraging social enterprises and strengthening local cooperation. In Korça, the Inclust project - Local Clusters and Incubators of Social Enterprises in the Field of Culture/Tourism and Popular Tradition, funded by the European Union within the IPA CBC Albania-Greece program, is an important initiative for the creation of local clusters and incubators of social enterprises in the field of culture and tourism. In Klos, the project E-MOTION: School mobilization for eco-innovation, funded by the government of Italy through the IADSA program, aims to involve the local community in the development of ecological innovations through social incubators. Another project financed by the EU through the EU for Municipalities is the project Unleashing the Potential of Youth of

Lushnja, in Mat, the project Innovation and culture to develop Mat. In Fier, the project Open Tourism-Cross-Border cooperation network for an open-to-innovation tourism, financed by the European Union through the program IPA CBC Italy-Albania-Montenegro, is another initiative that includes the creation of local clusters for the development of tourism based on innovation.

• Preservation of culture and historical heritage:

Albania has undertaken a number of projects for the preservation and promotion of its culture and historical heritage, focusing on the restoration of important historical objects and the strengthening of national and regional identity. One of these projects is the reconstruction of the "Fato Berberi" Cultural Center in Gjirokastër, supported by the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania - Greece program.

In Përmet, the "Thematic CB tourism development through the preservation of stone craftsmanship (STONE.ART)" project aims to preserve stone craftsmanship, an important tradition in this region. In Tropoja, the "New Reality of Heritage Sites" project, also funded by the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania - Montenegro program, focuses on preserving and promoting the cultural and historical heritage of the region. Another important project for the preservation of architectural and cultural heritage is "AR.C.H.ETHICS - Architecture, Citizenship, History and Ethics to Shape Dissonant Heritage in European Cities", which takes place in Përmet with the support of the URBACT IV program of the European Union. In Pogradec, the project "Struga & Pogradec for the Promotion of Tourism and Cultural Heritage — COOLTOUR", supported by the European Union through the program IPA CBC Albania - Macedonia, aims to promote the cultural heritage of Pogradec and Struga, encouraging cross-border cooperation and the development of cultural tourism in both the cities.

• Reconstruction and revitalization of sports facilities:

In Berat, the Sports Area project at the Velabisht school, financed by Swiss Cooperation within the framework of the HAP/Health for Program, includes the construction of a sports area at the "Velabisht" school. In Gjirokastër, the Bilal Golemi mini-football field project, financed by the European Union within the "Europe for Citizens" program, aims to build a mini-football field. In Skrapar, the project Construction of a sports center at the Zylyftar Veleshnja school, Çorovodë, financed by the European Union through the EU for Municipalities program, in Mat, the project Construction of the football field for the Upper middle school Ali Metra school, financed by the Slovenian Government, in Klos, the FIRST STEPS project: Support for the environment, participation and sport in the Municipality of Klos, financed by the European Union within the EU for Municipalities program and in Kukës, the Sport project and entertainment, financed by Swiss Cooperation through the HAP/Health for Program, aims to create sports infrastructure and organize activities that promote a healthy lifestyle for young people and the local community.

7.6 Public Safety

The project in Cërrik, entitled "Cross-border fire protection", is an initiative funded by the European Union within the IPA CBC Albania-Macedonia program. In Elbasan, the "RAYS-RAYS" project, supported by the British Government, is focused on an initiative aimed at improving community skills. In Gramsh, the "New Opportunities for Safe Winter Adventure" project, funded by the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania-Macedonia program, aims to develop new opportunities for safe winter tourism. In Pogradec, the project "Improving the provision of services in cases of emergencies and natural disasters" is an initiative funded by JICA, the Japanese International Cooperation Agency. In Shkodër, the "Building Smart Forest" project, funded by the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania-Montenegro program, aims to create and manage smart forests.

7.7 Agriculture, forest management

The municipalities are implementing 6 projects which contribute to the better management and protection of forests and biodiversity. The total funding amounts to 1.19 million euros, of which 0.98 million euros are the contribution of donors and 0.19 million euros are co-financing. Projects in this functional area are financed by the EU and the Italian government.

Below are some interventions funded to improve services related to agriculture, forest management and biodiversity:

• In the field of forest protection and management:

In Lezha, with the support of JICA (Japanese Agency for International Cooperation), the project to provide a fire extinguisher for the municipality was carried out, contributing to the protection of forests from fires and improving the capacities to cope with environmental emergencies in the region. In Tropoja, the European Union, through the program IPA CBC Albania – Montenegro, has supported the project "Promoting the Sustainable Use of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants for the Improvement of Livelihood and the Conservation of Biodiversity"

Promoting the sustainable use of medicinal and aromatic plants:

The European Union through the IPA program CBC Albania - Greece is implementing projects like "E-Natura" in Berat, in Dropull the "Innovative Action for the Use of Pharmaceutical Plants in Transboundary Cultural Heritage (Herbino)" project is being implemented, while in Gjirokastër, a similar project entitled "HERBINNO" focuses on the conservation and sustainable use of medicinal and aromatic plants. In Divjak, with the support of Italy through the IADSA program, the "Rapid Response Agro-Lab Divjake" project is being implemented, which aims to improve agro-laboratory services to increase the production and sustainable use of agricultural and medicinal resources in the region.

7.8 The digitization of services

The digitization of local government services offers numerous benefits to both government units and to the citizens that they serve. The main advantages of digitizing services include improving

accessibility, ensuring that citizens can access government services at their convenience, reducing the need for physical visits to government offices; increasing efficiency: simplifying processes, reducing the time it takes to complete transactions or obtain information; cost savings, increased transparency by providing citizens with real-time access to information about government services, budgets and decisions.

In Berat, the "Cultural Land" project, financed by the European Union within the IPA CBC Albania-Greece program, aims to promote and preserve cultural heritage in the region.

The European Union through the Interreg ADRION 2014-2020 program, has funded in Durrës the "PoWER - Ports as Steering Wheels of the Entrepreneurial Field" project, in Gjirokastër, the "ADRINETBOOK" project, in Tepelën, the "Adriatic Landscape Interpretation" project. In Përmet, the "Exploring the cultural heritage" project of the cross-border region through a digital library and oral sources (EXPLORAL)" is another initiative funded by the European Union through the IPA CBC Albania-Greece program.

In Tirana, the European Union through the Horizon Europe program supports the project "Command and Operations Mechanism for the Multisectoral Analysis of Disaster Data Nexus". This project aims to create a mechanism for the multi-sectoral analysis of data related to disasters, strengthening the institutions' abilities to manage crises and environmental emergencies. Also in Tirana, the Council of Europe has supported a similar project, which focuses on creating mechanisms for the analysis and management of data related to disasters and emergencies.

7.9 The democratization process and the Civil Society

Albania has participated in a number of projects funded by the European Union within programs such as "Europe for Citizens", ReLOaD, and IPA CBC, which aim to improve the local democracy, civic education and the community involvement.

In Kamez, the European Union through the ReLOaD program has funded a grant to support local initiatives that promote democracy and civic inclusion. Kavaja is included in the Regional Program of the Project for Local Democracy in the Western Balkans (ReLOaD2). In Kukes, the European Union has funded the "Reload" project through the ReLOaD program, which focuses on supporting initiatives that improve the local democracy and increase the community involvement in decision-making processes. In Patos, the EU has financed the Regional Program for Local Democracy. In Saranda, the European Union has supported projects within the ReLOaD program, which aim to strengthen local democracy and increase citizen involvement in decision-making processes, helping to develop the community and improve local governance.

In Lezha, the European Union has supported two important projects through the "Europe for Citizens" program. The first project, "Debating the Future of Europe and Challenging Euroscepticism", aims to promote media literacy and combat Eurosceptic narratives by engaging citizens in dialogue on the future of Europe. The second project, "Alternative Narratives for Tolerance and Intercultural Dialogue", aims to promote intercultural dialogue and combat stereotypes through activities that promote equality and social inclusion. In Elbasan, the project "Solidarity, the key to solving social problems and supporting the evolution of Europe in the future" is an initiative also financed by the European Union through the "Europe for Citizens" program

In Librazhd, the "Revision" project, funded by the European Union through the "Europe for Citizens" program, aims to support local communities in revising their practices and improving civic dialogue for local development.

In Lushnje, the European Union has supported several projects through various programs. The "ReLOaD II" project is a continuation of the local democracy program, which aims to improve local governance and promote citizen involvement. Also, the "Europe Goes Local" project aims to strengthen the capacities of municipalities to support and improve activities involving young people in community development. The project "Quality Label, European Solidarity Corps" as well as the project "Live Free in the Melting Pot" are two other such projects.

In Roskovec, the "ADRI COM" project, financed by the European Union within the IPA CBC Italy-Albania-Montenegro program, aims to improve cross-border cooperation through activities that strengthen ties between the communities of the Adriatic region.
